#### Tax-exempt status update

The association has regained its 501(c)6 tax-exempt status, but the attorney advised that transitioning to a 501(c)3 would be difficult due to the majority of funding coming from membership dues rather than sponsorships. The group discussed the pros and cons of pursuing 501(c)3 status and a political action committee, ultimately deciding the administrative burden is too high for the organization's current size and resources.

### Membership renewal process

The group agreed to continue the successful approach of sending out membership renewal invoices in early December, with a cutoff date of end of January. This has resulted in a high renewal rate in previous years.

## **Sturgeon fishing proposal**

Marc Bush proposed the idea of transitioning the sturgeon fishery to a tag/lottery system, rather than the current short open seasons. The group discussed the potential benefits and challenges of this approach, including enforcement, participation, and coordination with Oregon. They agreed to further discuss and refine the proposal offline.

#### Steelhead fishing season update

The group discussed the recent steelhead fishing town hall meetings, noting that while initial reports were positive, recent closures on certain rivers like the Hump and Chehalis were disappointing. They plan to get an update on the final season recommendations at the next town hall meeting on November 13th.

The group wrapped up the meeting, with the president noting he may need to reschedule the next meeting in early December due to a potential out-of-state trip. He wished everyone a happy Thanksgiving and thanked the veterans for their service.
