Fathom Notetaker Discussion

- Considered using Fathom AI notetaking service for \$15/month
- Cary suggested using ChatGPT as a free alternative
- Agreed to try ChatGPT method first before committing to paid service

Logbook App Issues

- Android users still experiencing problems submitting trips
- Only 54% of guides have filled out a logbook form at least once
- Concerns raised about potential enforcement issues due to app malfunctions
- Discussion of possibly eliminating paper logs despite app problems

Washington Sports Show Booth

- Considering half-price booth to increase association visibility
- Discussed logistics of staffing booth for 5-day show
- Will email members to gauge interest in volunteering to work the booth
- Need to develop talking points and materials for booth

Grays Harbor Salmon Policy

- New policy lowers Chehalis system Chinook escapement goal from 12,000 to 9,000
- Concerns raised about shift from habitat-based to MSY-based escapement goals
- Policy lacks consideration of predation issues in the system
- Public comments due by September 15th

WDFW Leadership Updates

- Two candidates applied for WDFW Director position to replace James Losee
- One internal candidate (likely Chad Herring) and one external
- WDFW leadership emphasizing need for right fit, may reopen search if needed

Columbia River Fishing

- Upcoming compact meeting to discuss potential season extensions
- Concerns about Snake River URB (Upriver Bright) Chinook returns may limit opportunities

Next Steps

- Compile costs and logistics for potential sports show booth
- Try ChatGPT for meeting notes and evaluate effectiveness
- Follow up with Kelly Cunningham on Android logbook app issues
