Coastal Steelhead Rules

- Permanent rules being finalized, mostly positive changes:
 - Seasons open until end of March
 - Bait allowed through December
 - Hatchery limit reduced to 2 fish
 - Most "no boat fishing" regulations removed
- Upper Hoh to close end of February instead of March
- Public testimony opportunity at upcoming commission meeting

Hatcher Wild Coexist Fundraiser

- Scheduled for December 5th
- WSGA considering sponsoring a table (~\$50-85/seat)
- Bob working on securing speakers and auction items

Drano Lake Steering Committee

- Marc Bush invited to participate by Skamania County commissioner
